## Proposed Amendments to BARC Constitution

OFFICERS: $\qquad$ ARTICLE II
Sec. 1 - Only members in good standing whose dues are paid in full at the time of their nomination and who are licensed amateur radio operators shall be elected to a club office. (unchanged from Pete Becker's recommendations)

Sec. 2 - The officers of this club shall be: A president, a vice-president, a secretary-treasurer, a public information officer, and four (4) directors. The president, vice-president, secretarytreasurer, and public information officer shall be elected annually for a term of one year. The directors shall each be elected for a term of two years, with two directors elected in evennumbered years and two directors elected in odd-numbered years. (Unchanged from Pete Becker's recommendations)

Sec. 3 - Candidates for officers of the club shall be nominated at the November meeting, by members in good standing by the November meeting. The officers of the Club shall be elected at the December meeting by secret ballot or other means of members in good standing whose dues are paid in full at the time of the meeting and who are present at the December meeting.

Sec. 4 - Vacancies occurring between elections must shall be filled by special ballot, with nominations made at the first regular meeting following the occurrence of the vacancy and election at the second regular meeting following the occurrence of the vacancy by secret ballot of dues-paying members in good standing present at the meeting. Members elected shall fill the remainder of the term of the vacated office. (Unchanged from Pete Becker's recommendations)

Sec. 5 - Officers may be removed on motion by a three-fourths vote of the membership. (Unchanged from Pete Becker's recommendations)
